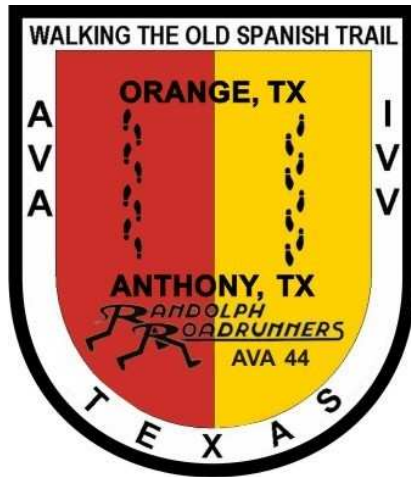


WALKING THE OLD SPANISH TRAIL (OST)

In Texas (Auto Highway)

A new "Special Events Program" approved by the TVA and hosted by the **Randolph Roadrunners** will begin January 1, 2008 and end December 31, 2011.



This Special Program will promote doing any event that runs along or crosses or is in very close proximity to any part of the Old Spanish Trail auto highway in the State of Texas.

Year round (YRE) walks, as well as regular one-day or weekend walks may qualify for this event as long as they are on the OST. Each entry in the OST Special Event booklet must have a different sanction number.

Participants must complete twenty (20) different walks to be eligible to receive the special patch designed specifically for this special event.

Upon completion of the required 20 events, the participant will be awarded the 3.5" x 4.25" 100% multi-colored embroidered iron-on patch similar to the one pictured above. The cost of the patch is included in the book fee.
