Convention Committee Jerry Wilson - Chair AVA CONVENTIONS AND THE 2023 OLYMPIAD

The 2023 IVV Olympiad has been awarded to the AVA. This is a major step in being further recognized worldwide. The IVV Olympiad takes place every two years in an IVV member country. The IVV Olympiad includes walking, swimming, and cycling, and additional types of Volkssport events. The supporting program offers participants many opportunities to make and cultivate international friendships in a harmonious atmosphere. The 2023 IVV Olympiad in San Antonio, TX will be the 18th international event held, following the rescheduled 17th IVV Olympiad in South Korea during October 2022.

With the awarding of the 2023 IVV Olympiad the AVA National Board voted in January to not hold a 2023 AVA Biennial Convention and instead convene a national general membership meeting on a convenient 2023 date, a meeting held in accordance with association bylaws. This move is deemed necessary to provide for robust AVA member attendance at the 2023 IVV Olympiad. This allows National Office to better focus on coordinating the Olympiad while not pressing potential attendees to travel for two separate national events or travel for a greatly extended time period away from home. To this end 2023 convention hosting applications will not be entertained.

The 2021 AVA Biennial Convention continues to be planned for June 29 – July 2, with pre-convention events June 26 – 29, and post-convention events on July 3. Online registration is open; please see the AVA website front page. While registering be sure to follow links to the Silent Auction to enter your donation for public auction, and to volunteer to support convention delivery. The AVA Convention Committee is keeping a close eye on

COVID-19 conditions and requirements in Madison, WI. The National Board in March 2021 will revisit convention plans to determine what health considerations need be adhered to, including but not anticipating, canceling the Convention, unless absolutely necessary. With an abundance of caution we approach the 2021 AVA Biennial Convention



AVA CONVENTION JUNE 29- JULY 3, 2021

The AVA is closely monitoring the impact of COVID-19 in Madison, WI, site of our 2021 Convention. The AVA Board of Directors in consultation with the Convention Committee, the National Office, and the Madison Sports Commission will meet in March to evaluate the situation and determine how to move forward with the planning or cancellation of the convention. 

This **6km or 10km** walk takes you through the 200-acre Crownridge Canyon Natural Area and a very picturesque residential upscale neighborhood with amazing views of downtown San Antonio. The walk is rated 2B. Alcohol, bikes and pets are not allowed in the park.

Crownridge Canyon was the first city natural area developed as part of the Edwards Aquifer Protection ballot initiative. The 200-acre preserve features Level 1 ADA trails and Level 4 hiking trails through a variety of habitats. Features include a canopy level bridge overlook, beautiful forested canyon bottoms, hillside vistas, and restored grasslands. This year-round walk normally starts at the Hillview Inn at La Cantera but for PI DAY we will have a start table at the entrance to the park at 7222 Luskey Blvd.
