As we get closer to the 2021 AVA Biennial Convention we are coming down to the wire and things keep changing! Change apparently is the name of the game. What we need from everyone intending to come to Madison is that you get registered as soon as possible. Final numbers as of May 15 will affect our planning; some low numbers may result in cancelling specific plans. Sooner registration will aid convention planners.

June 23: Final day to register online through midnight. Payment via USPS should be received by June 25. June 28: In-person registration will begin on site at Monona Terrace, One John Nolen Dr., Madison.
June 28: 1:00 - 5:00 pm will be a soft convention registration opening with

fully staffed registration starting the morning of Tuesday, June 29.

Our plans for multiple options on Wednesday evening of the Convention are dwindling. One big attraction was to attend a weekly Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra concert on the grass of the state Capitol building, however it has been canceled due to Covid-19 precautions. The National Office will handle refunds for those having already ordered the Wednesday food and beverage package and picnic blanket.

Committee members and National Office representatives have had several discussions with representatives from the Monona Terrace Convention Center and the Concourse Hotel, our convention hotel, about Covid-19 cleaning precautions. The Monona Terrace Convention has worked with us to move inside events to larger rooms so we can better spread out, and we are planning some functions held outside with inside weather precaution areas just in case, larger than needed so attendees can spread out.

Monona Terrace has received GBAC Star Accreditation for their Covid-19 related cleaning procedures. All areas are sanitized following use for your protection.

On the AVA website, under the Convention information button you can find FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions). Look for updates from now until the end of the Convention. We learn as we go.

Volunteers are still needed: We are always looking for volunteers, both at the four pre-convention sites, but also every day in Madison, Tuesday through Saturday mid-day. Those that put their name in during the 2019 general session in Albany will be contacted during May to confirm their availability and area of interest.

One additional cancellation that was a potential draw for people to stay in Madison before the actual convention and drive daily to each pre-convention event site was the Madison fireworks display scheduled for the Saturday preceding the Convention, Saturday, June 26. Referred to as Shake the Lake

in early TAW convention articles, with fireworks displayed over one of our four lakes. It too has been cancelled. Sorry! Madison remains a site central to the four pre-convention sites for those that prefer not to change hotels/motels nightly. Stay healthy! See you in June in the upper Midwest!

36th Annual Spring Volksmarch - June 5 and June 6, 2021

Registration: Registration for the Volksmarch occurs the day of the Hike. Registration tables are located in the parking lot west of the Welcome Center, near the starting line. Cost: Admission to the Memorial for hikers is discounted to \$10/one person, \$15/two people, and \$20/three or more people. Additionally, hikers pay \$3 to the Volkssport Association upon registration (cash or check). Non-hikers visiting the Memorial pay regular admission rates. Parking is free, with complimentary shuttle service to and from outer parking lots. Hikers are encouraged to bring 3 cans of food as a

charitable donation to local food drives. Donations of food are not a substitute for the admission fee to the Memorial or fee to the Volkssport Association.

Time: Gates to the Memorial open at 6AM. Registration is from 7AM-1PM. The Hike begins at 8AM and hikers must be off the trail by 4PM. The complex and Laughing Water Restaurant® open at 6AM.



America's Walking Club to Host IVV Olympiad in February 2023

The Olympiad will be held in conjunction with the Texas Trail Roundup - another international event cosponsored by America's Walking Club's Texas state association and the International Marching League (IML). This arrangement will afford international travelers the opportunity to spend a full week or more experiencing the best San Antonio and the USA have to offer. The back-to-back festivals are timed to showcase one of the most uniquely American of sporting events — San Antonio's award-winning annual Stock Show & Rodeo.

It is a great honor for the international community to award America's Walking Club the opportunity to host the 2023 IVV Olympiad here in San Antonio, the home of our national organization.

For the first time the Olympiad will be held in the Americas. Planning for the 2023 IVV Olympiad has begun and further updates will be available as it progresses.

A second IML walking festival in America known as the US Freedom Walk Festival, is held annually in Arlington, VA with the next scheduled event 15-17 October 2021.
