#### Olympiad – February 19-23 IML – February 24-26

Excitement is mounting for the 18th Olympiad/IML events right in our own back yard. As of 18 January walkers from 24 countries and 40 states have Pre-registered.

If you have done a volksmarch or not, seeing and being part of the parade of nations when each country will carry their country flag is a must. The parade of nations will begin with a marching band at the Gazebo in King Williams and be greeted by mariachis at the Arneson River Theater where the opening ceremony will take place. This will be followed by a free Elvis concert at 4 pm.

So, gather your American flags and pins to exchange or give to our foreign guests. The finish for each event will be at the Cos House at the Olympiad Village. Each day there will be live music and food vendors along with various props for pictures. I'm getting excited as I hope you are for this once in a life time experience right here in San Antonio.

# West Texas Trail Walkers

#### Palo Duro Canyon State Park - October 6-8, 2023

Mark your calendars for October 6-8, 2023 for the West Texas Trail Walkers annual hiking event. We will be returning to the Panhandle of Texas to hike the trails in Palo Duro State Park. The hikes will range from easier 5k walks to more challenging 15k hikes. Palo Duro Canyon is the second largest canyons in the United States and offers over 30 miles of trails. The canyon is known for its red rock formations and ridges that are rugged and beautiful.

Because Palo Duro is the most popular state park in Texas and October is prime season, we suggest getting your hotel reservations early. Canyon, Texas is the nearest large city with nationally known hotel chains. Holiday Inn Express, Best Western and Hampton Inns are just off the Canyon I-27 exit. There is also camping available at the state park and reservations can be made by going on-line to reserveamerica.com.

As you know, it takes a core group of volunteers to organize a hiking event of this magnitude. We always need volunteers to serve as hiking directors and assistant hiking directors for each day, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. These volunteers set up the hikes, determine the check points and trail markings, create a map and directions, coordinate the worker's walks and recruit several volunteers to help out on the day of the hike. Since our hikes use established state park trails and maps, the walk directors don't need to do much background preparation.

If you are interested in helping out as a walk director or assistant walk director, please consider joining us for the reconnaissance trip to Palo Duro Canyon State Park, March 5-9, 2023. The "Recon" is always a lot of fun, it gives you another chance to enjoy the

great outdoors of West Texas and you are invited to our special "thank you dinner."
