BACK-TO-THE-BEGINNING

The RANDOLPH ROADRUNNERS Volkssport Club was chartered by the AVA on 27 March 1980 as the **44**th club in the United States and the 14th in Texas. The club just observed its 27th Birthday!

Last year the founder of the club proposed a BACK-TO-THE-**BEGINNING** program to recognize the genesis and development of the RANDOLPH ROADRUNNERS Volkssport Club.

The concept revealed at the March Club Meeting was to hold a special event to mirror the RANDOLPH

ROADRUNNERS first event or first years: a walk, bike and swim along with a fest of music, food and drinks. 1980 prices would be charged for the events and a commemorative medal would be awarded. Special sale items such as a cap, T-shirt, sweat shirt, polo shirt, and the like would be produced.

Past club event giveaway and sale items, newsletters, photographs and memorabilia would be displayed and past club officers would be invited to take part in the festivities including the founding group and other volkssport dignitaries.

The initial step in **B-t-t-B** project development is the selection of a date. Times to consider include but are not limited to:

...Date of Event #1 (May-June)

...Date of Event #2 (December)

...Date of TeXas 10 (second weekend in August)

...Date of Charter (March) **AND...**should it be in 2008(BD-28). 2009(BD-29), or 2010(BD-30)?

Setting a date will be a primary discussion item at the April Club Meeting along with the appointment of a planning group. The magnitude envisioned for this project requires the entire club membership to play a role...big or small, but everyone's involvement will be important.

YOUR ideas and YOUR attendance at the April meeting will help get this project initialized. YOUR thinking and contributions are essential to make **B-t-t-B** an event to remember in volkssport circles.

SE Regional Road Trip!

The following is a schedule from Marvin Stokes, Regional Director for the Southeast Region, regarding an organized volkssport trip called, FIESTA SAN ANTONIO & OTHER YRES. A group of walkers led by Marvin Stokes, (many of them are folks who went to the Disney World walk that David Toth did last November) intend to be here for Fiesta. The following itinerary was sent by Marvin F.Y.I. for anyone who would like to join their group walks.

Sunday, April 22nd --Shiner, TX. We should arrive between 10:00-10:30 a.m. and plan to do the Downtown YRE Y0559. We are going to allow three hours for the walk and for lunch. We plan to depart Shiner between 1:00-1:30 p.m. headed for San Antonio. There will be 31 walkers. We would certainly appreciate any locals who would like to accompany us and also to make recommendations for a good lunch spot (preferably Bar-B-Que or Mexican and serves Shiner Bock!)

Sunday, April 22nd --San Antonio. We should arrive in San Antonio between 2:45-3:00 p.m. We have a barge ride on the San Antonio River

scheduled at that time and when we return, we will be doing the Riverwalk Y0055. We will do this as an evening stroll and shopping spree walk. We hope to begin the walk between 4:30-4:45 p.m. We will allow 3.5 hours for walk, shopping & dinner and depart the Riverwalk between 8:15-8:30 p.m. headed for our hotel for the next 4 nights. Again, anyone who would like to go along with us is more than welcome. All help and recommendations are also welcome.

Tuesday, April 24th --Fredericksburg, TX. We will start the day driving to the LBJ Ranch for a tour. After the LBJ Tour, drive to Fredericksburg. We plan to arrive in Fredericksburg between 11:30-Noon. We will allow 3.5 hours for the Fredericksburg YRE Historical Y0001 and lunch. Leave Fredericksburg between 3:30-3:45 p.m. and return to San Antonio.

Wednesday, April 25th --Ft Sam Houston YRE Y0261 arriving at Bldg 592 between 9:00-9:30 a.m. Allow 2.5 hours for walk. All help that can be provided with security, etc. would be appreciated for this YRE. We will depart Ft Sam between Noon-12:30 and head over to AVA Headquarters for a visit. We will have lunch somewhere along the way. After AVA HQs visit, it's back to the hotel and then a group dinner at the Republic of Texas Restaurant on the Riverwalk.

Thursday, April 26th --Depart San Antonio for Dallas with a stop in Austin. Should get to Austin for the Capitol YRE Y0068 between 9:30-9:45 a.m. We will allow 3.5 hours for the walk and lunch and plan our departure from Austin for between 1:00-1:30 p.m. Arrival in Dallas between 3:30-4:00 p.m.

Friday, April 27th -- After sightseeing visits to Downtown Big D and a tour of Texas Stadium, we will do the White Rock Lake Y0141 between 3:30-4:00 p.m.

The biggest problem I foresee might be parking for the bus (a 59 passenger Van Hool) at the various start points. The next one might be getting through the security procedures at Ft Sam. All help, advice, etc. will be fantastic. Thanks to everyone in advance!!!!! Marvin
